(1) Full line of federally permitted consumer 1.4G fireworks (i.e. firecrackers, roman candles, sky rockets, wire and wooden core sparklers, missile-type rockets, helicopters, aerial spinners, mine and shell devices, aerial shells and reloadable tubes, multiple tube devices, bottle rockets, etc.)

(2) A limited variety of federally approved 1.4G fireworks (in California items must comply with even tougher performance and construction standards) called State-approved Fireworks a.k.a. "Safe & Sane" fireworks. (i.e. handheld and ground base fountains, trick noisemakers, toy smoke devices, snakes, snappy caps, party poppers, ground spinners, wheel spinners, etc.) No aerial or exploding items.

(3) Novelty pyrotechnic items (i.e. toy smoke devices, snakes, party poppers, snap caps, etc.)

(4) In addition to novelty pyrotechnic items, these states allow handheld sparklers.

(5) No novelties in CT.

(6) MD has an Approved Listing

(7) Sparklers are allowed in ME at all times

(8) Full C but some limitations - check NH Fire Marshal website for list.

(9) Full C allowed to be sold ONLY to non-residents.

(10) Northern VA (NOVA) has seasonal dates and an approved list of permissible fireworks.
